Subject: Oppose H.4187 Section 31(b)(1) – Protect Hemp in Massachusetts

Dear Massachusetts Cannabis Regulators,

I am writing to urge you to oppose H.4187, Section 31(b)(1), which would require hemp manufacturers to obtain a marijuana manufacturing license in order to produce consumable CBD products.

This provision states that the Cannabis Control Commission “**shall not issue an endorsement unless the applicant holds an unencumbered license to manufacture marijuana-infused products.**” This would incorrectly regulate hemp like marijuana, creating unnecessary barriers for small businesses and limiting consumer access to safe, legal hemp products.

Please take action to:

Remove or amend Section 31(b)(1) so hemp manufacturers are not required to hold marijuana licenses

- Support fair, separate regulation for hemp products
- Advocate for removal of the 0.4 mg THC per container federal limit

Massachusetts consumers and small businesses depend on fair hemp regulations. I urge you to act now.
